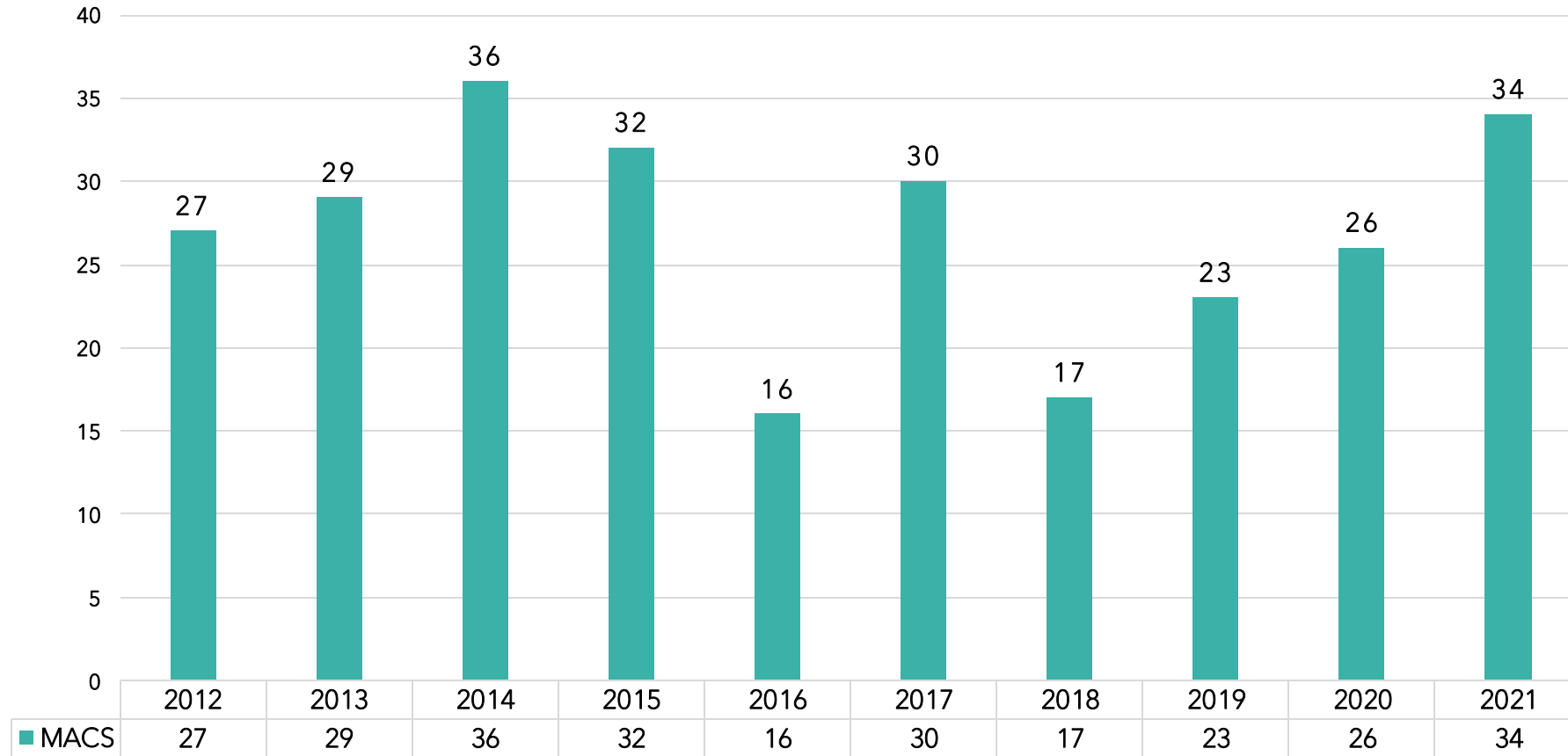


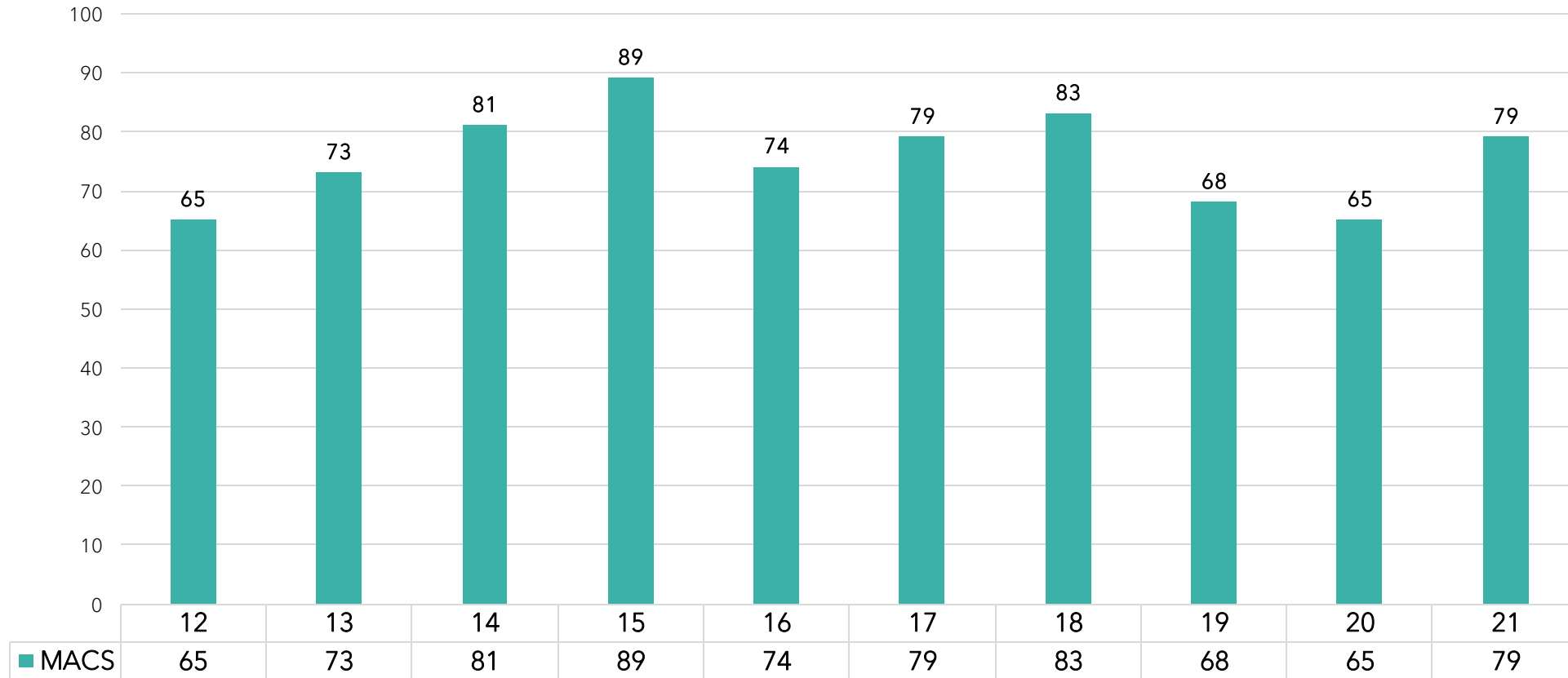

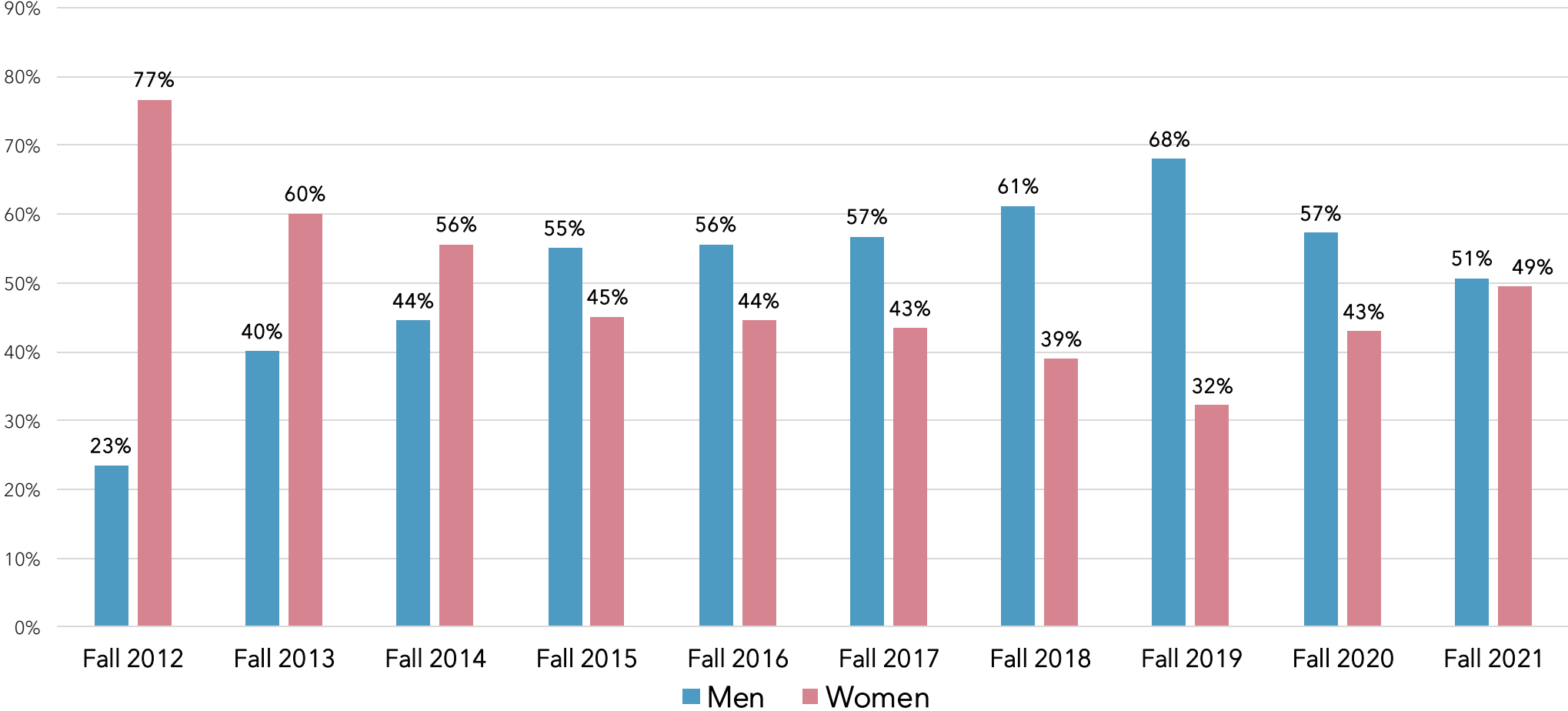
MACS Admission 2012-2021



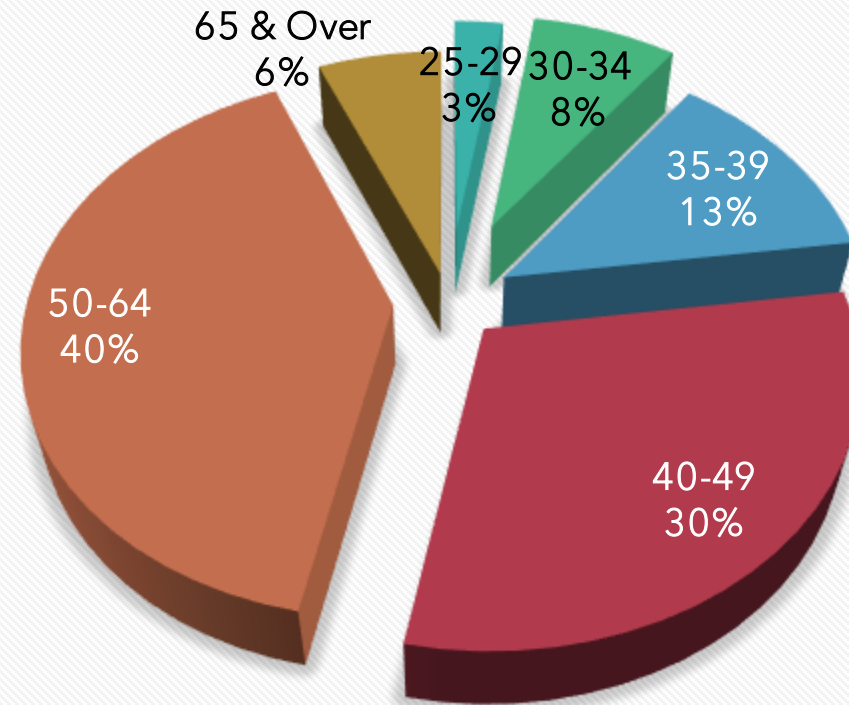
Enrollment: M.A.C.S. Degree Program (2012-2021)



Enrollment by Gender: M.A.C.S. Degree Program

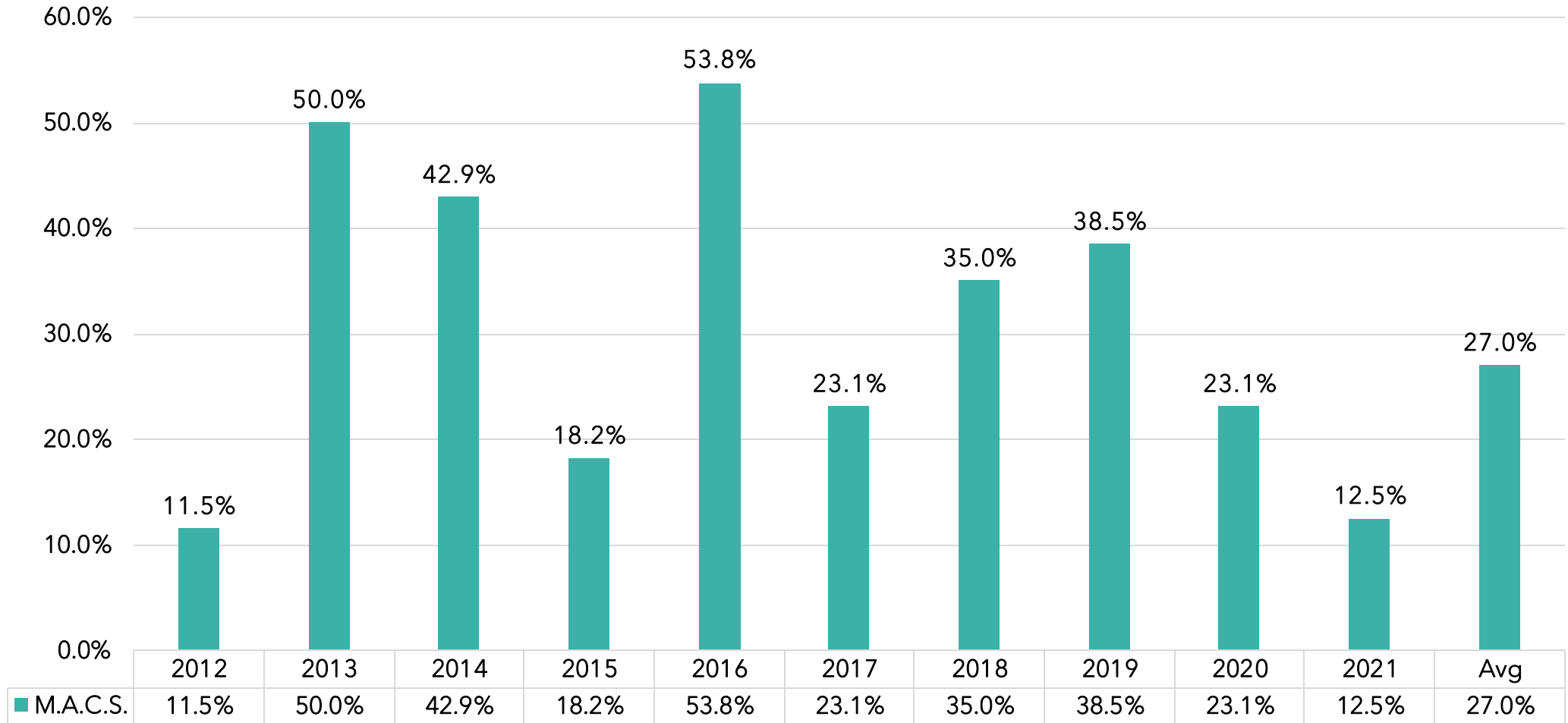


Fall 2021 Enrollment By Age: MACS Only

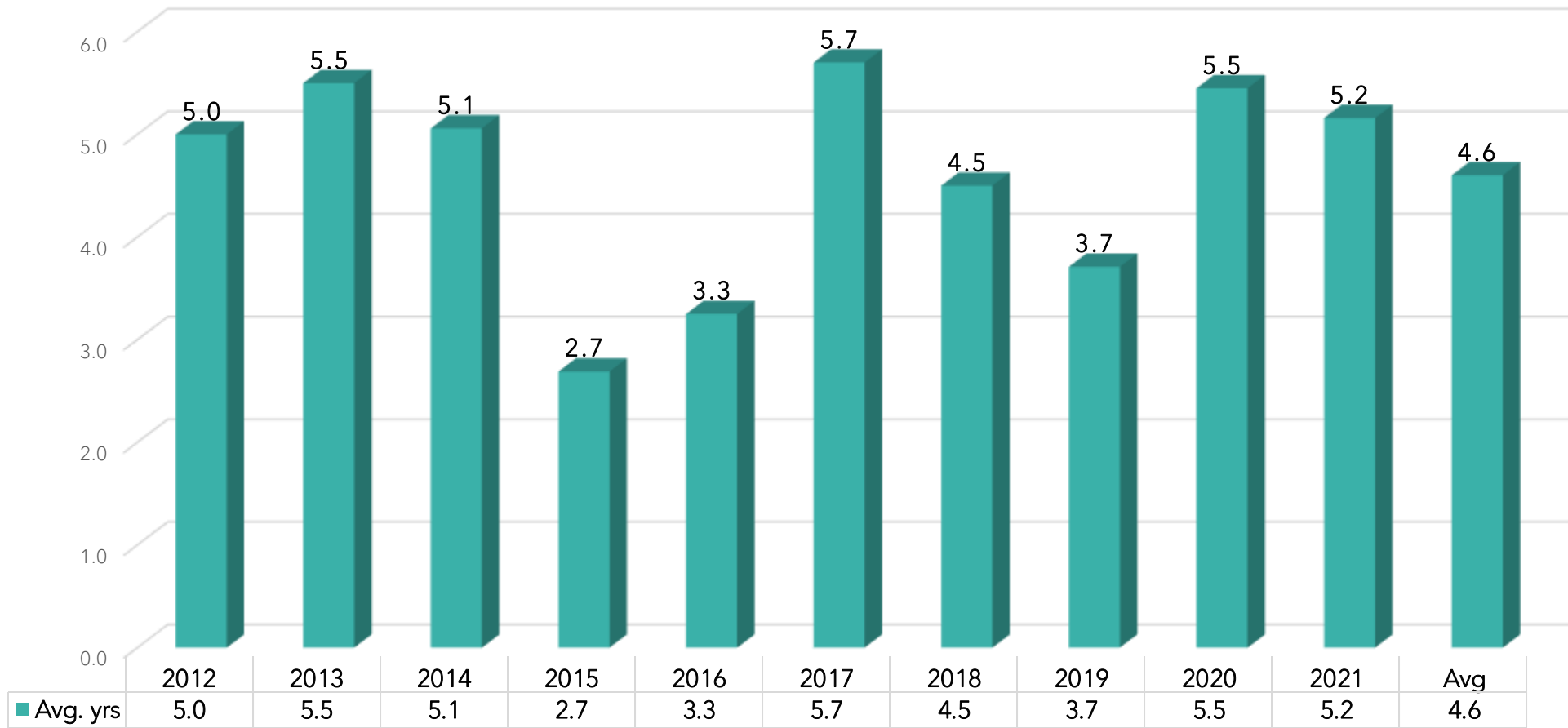

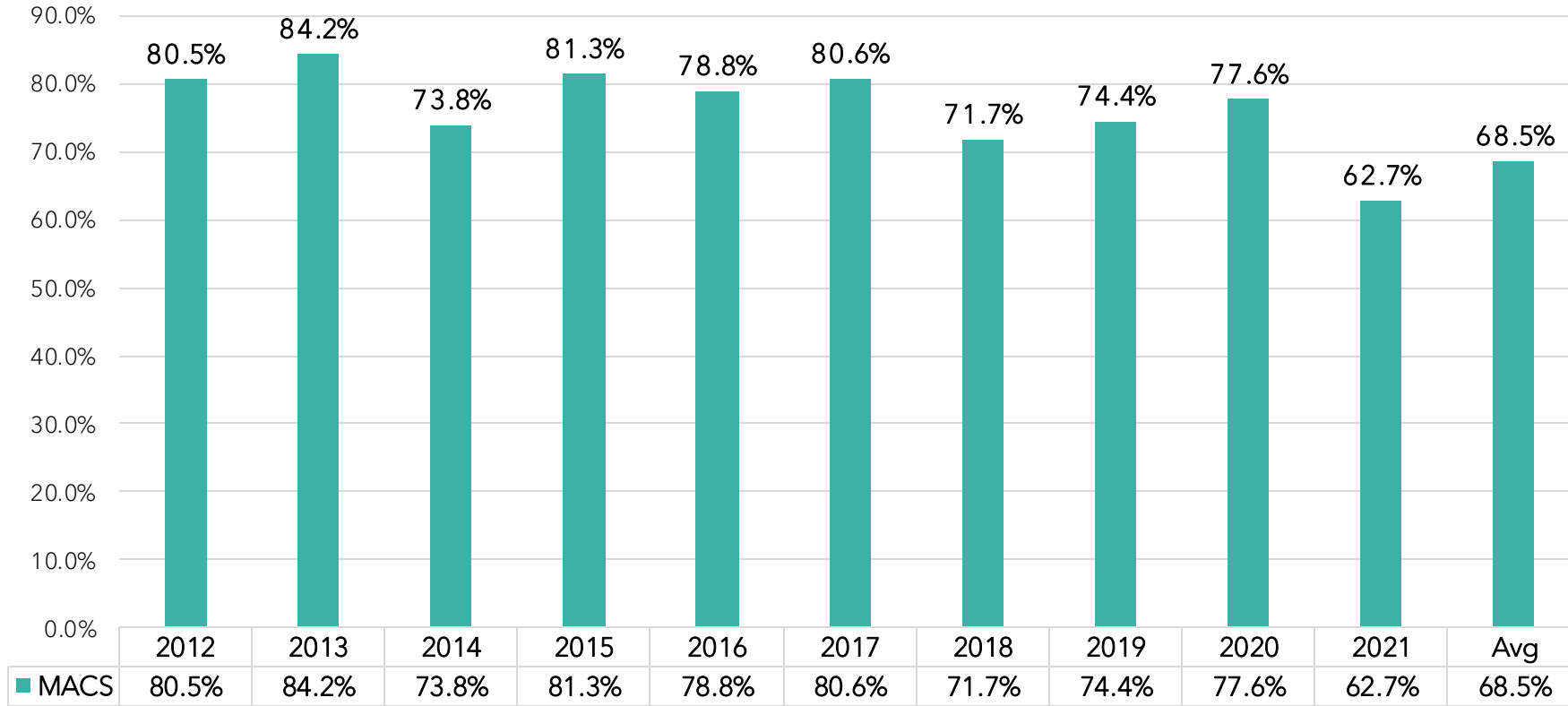
MACS Graduation Rate



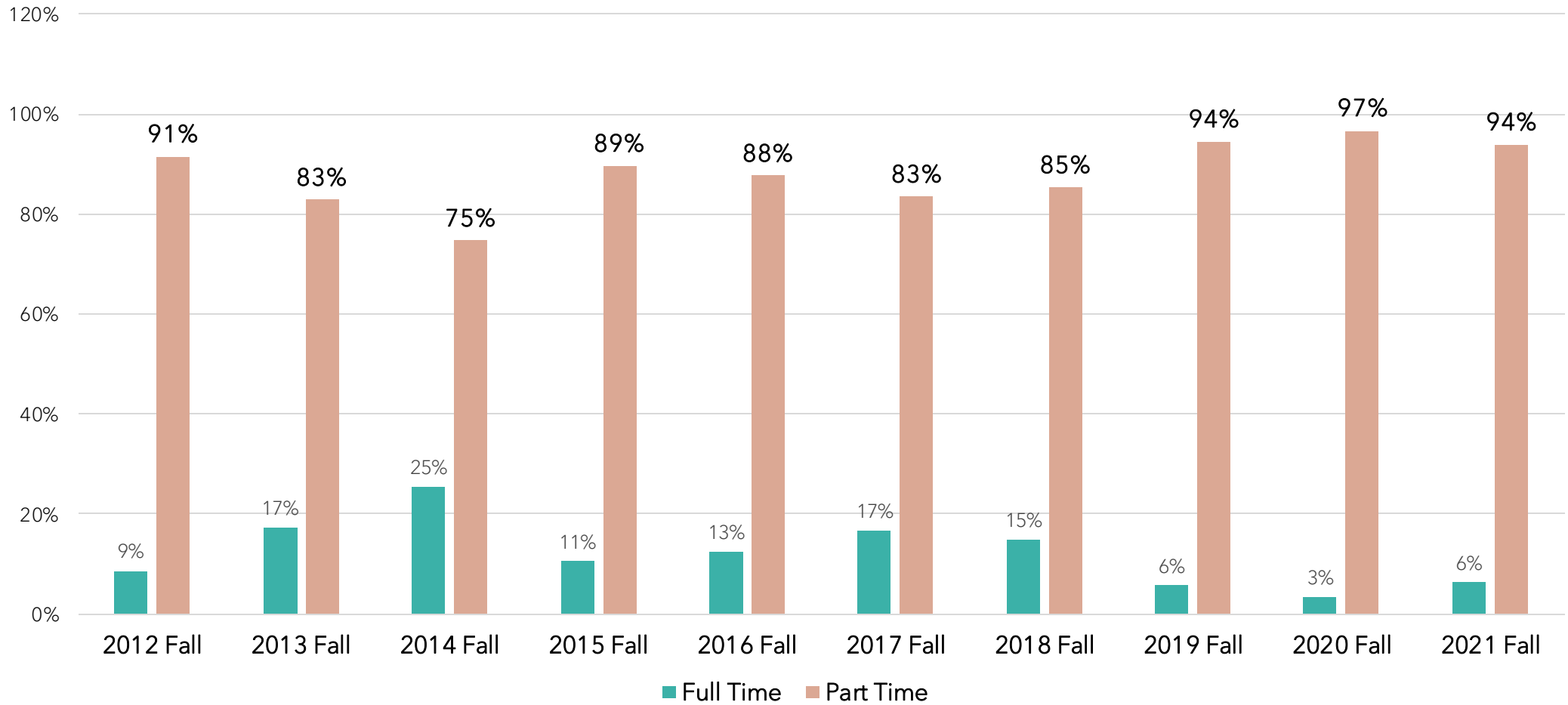
Average Number of Years to Graduate

MACS part-time vs full-time

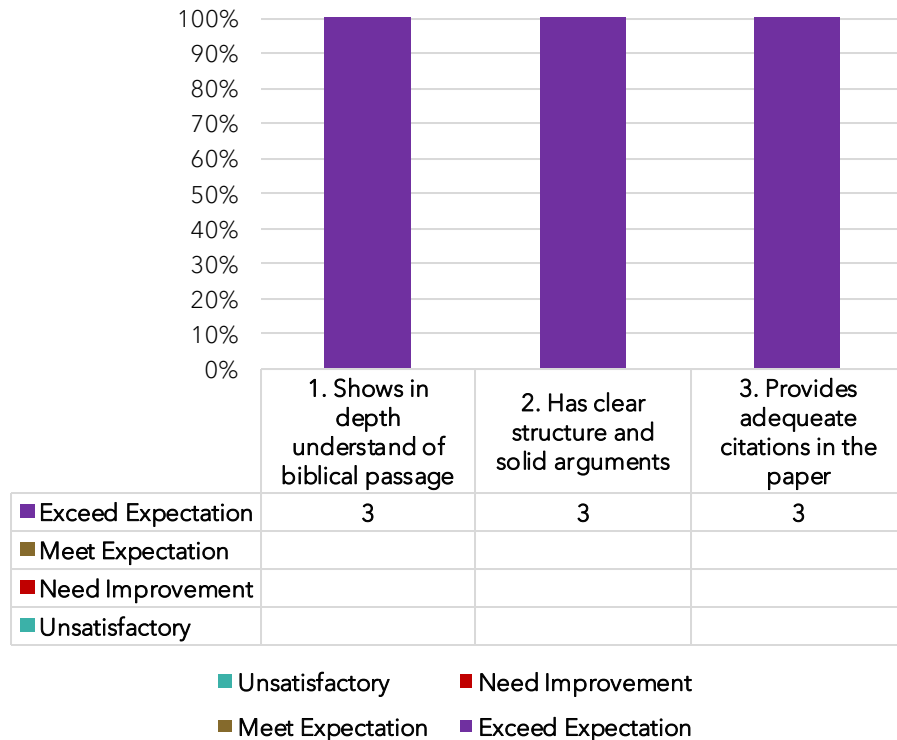

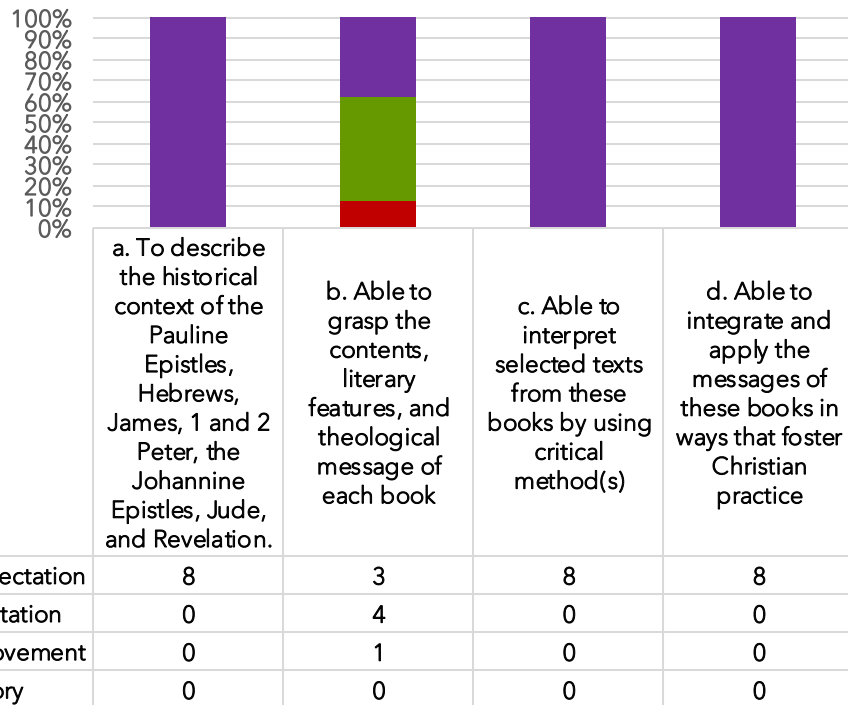

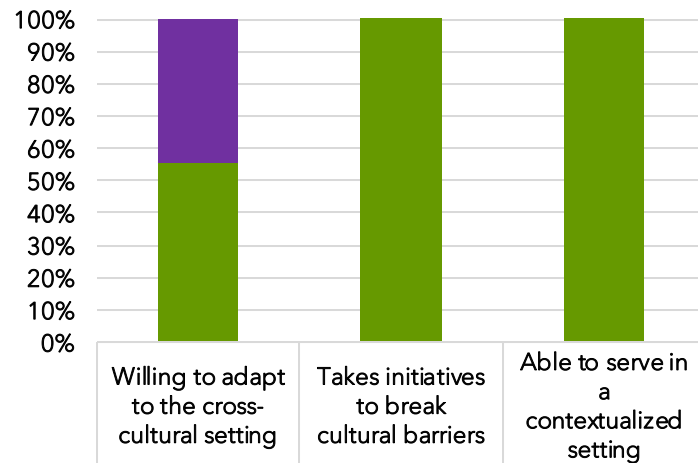

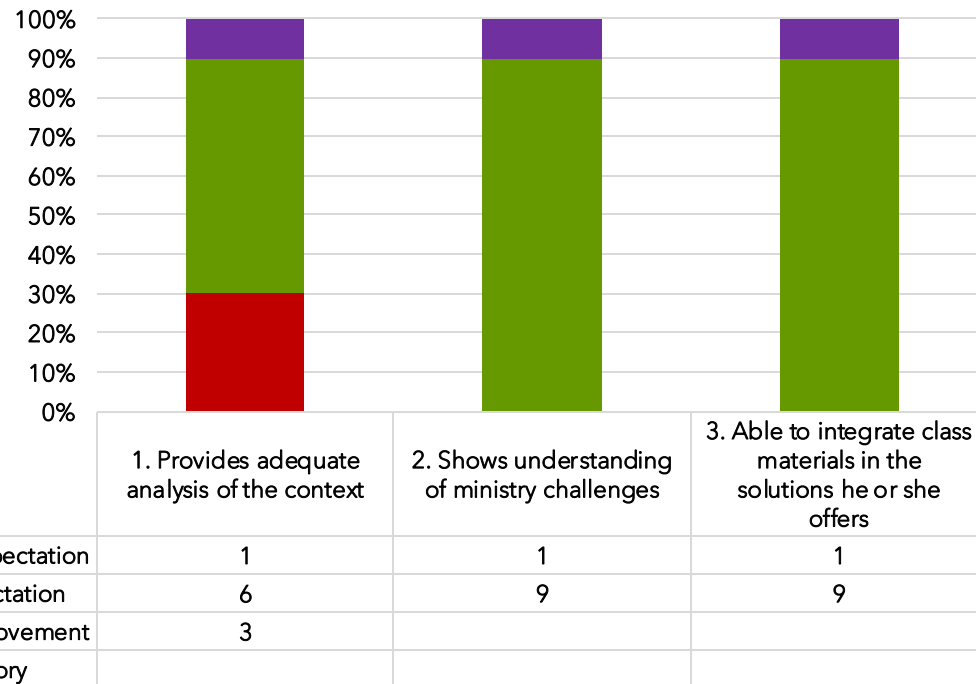

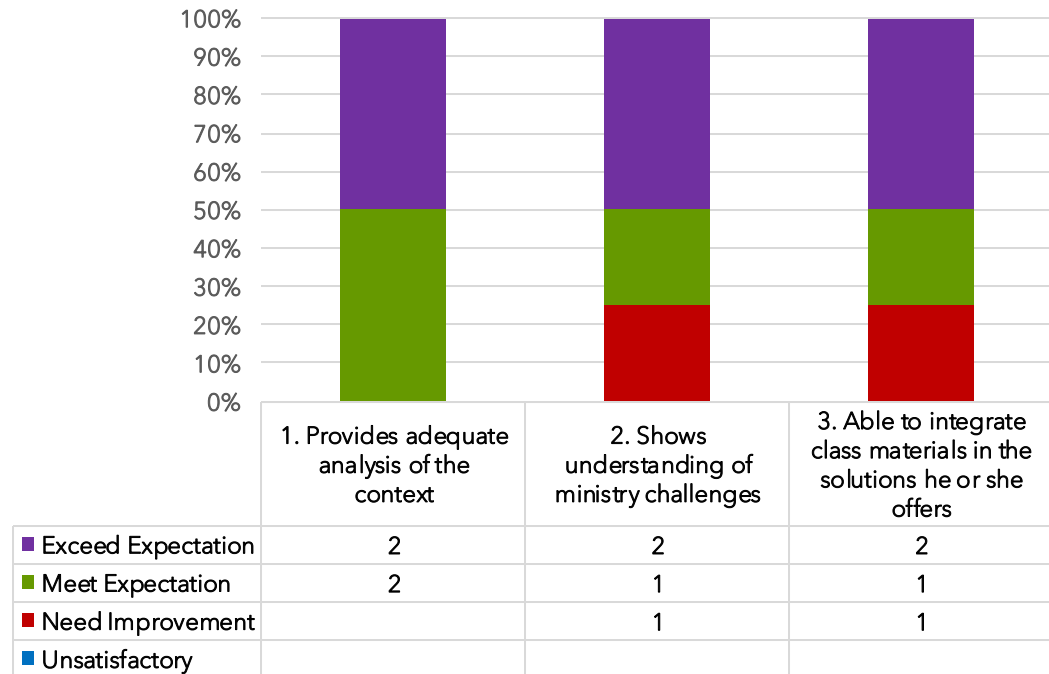

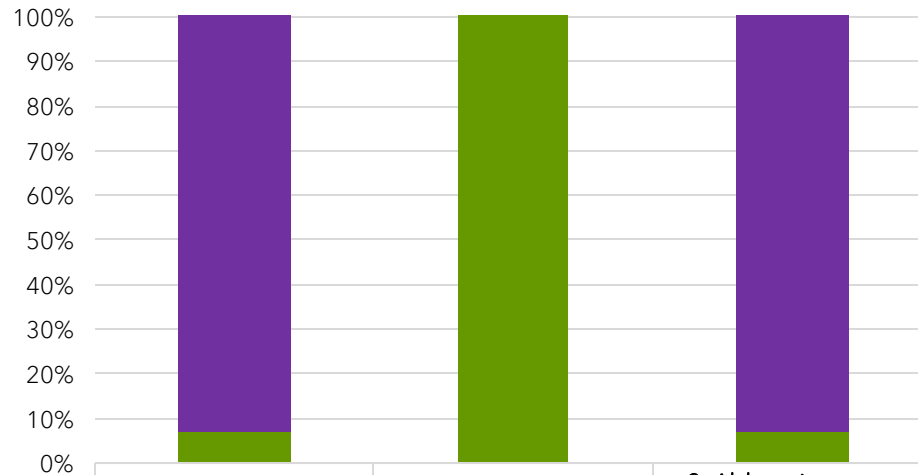
