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## Introduction

### 2020-2021 Logos Seminary Fact Book

Institutional Research (IR), as an intentional and directed service, was introduced at Logos Seminary in February 2009. The goal of IR is to identify, collect, and distribute key or necessary institutional data, to track institutional effectiveness, particularly with respect to strategic planning and departmental goals and key measurements. The 2009 Seminary Fact Book became the first concentrated and tangible reporting of IR by Logos Seminary. This publication is now in its twelfth year. ## I. Current Student Body Profile

### I.1 Highlights

- **Admissions:** The total number of admitted students for 2021 (academic year) is 96 which is the highest in Logo's history. 84.4% is for master's degree programs, and 15.6% is for Doctor of Ministry program. The average age of all admitted students is 45. Students are coming from regions of China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Canada, South Korea, Qatar, United Kingdom, and Jordan. 48 admitted students hold US citizenship which comprised 50% of total admitted students. The rest are either international students or alien residents reside in US.

- **Enrollment:** The total enrollment number has shown a small amount of increase for the past two years (15% for 2020 fall, 6% for 2021 fall). The worldwide Covid-19 pandemic seemed to be having indirect impact in this increase. The FTE enrollment has grown for all programs from 93.3 to 116.1.

- **Gender:** The overall enrollment percentage for female has increased and has reached more than 50% for two consecutive fall terms. Male in M.Div. program has decreased in the past four years. M.A.F.M. program continues to be the most popular program for female.

- **Age:** The percentage of all program students under the age of 40 is 23.93%. The age between 40-49 has the largest percentage for Master of Divinity students, 36.59%. The average age of all students is between 45 and 50. 54.97% of all program students are age 50 or above. This should be considered and reflected in the program and curriculum design.

- **Graduation and Retention Rate:** The graduation rate for all programs appears to be lowered continuously. The major factor is the increase of part-time and online students continuously. The retention rate for M.Div. and M.A.C.S. programs have improved from previous year.

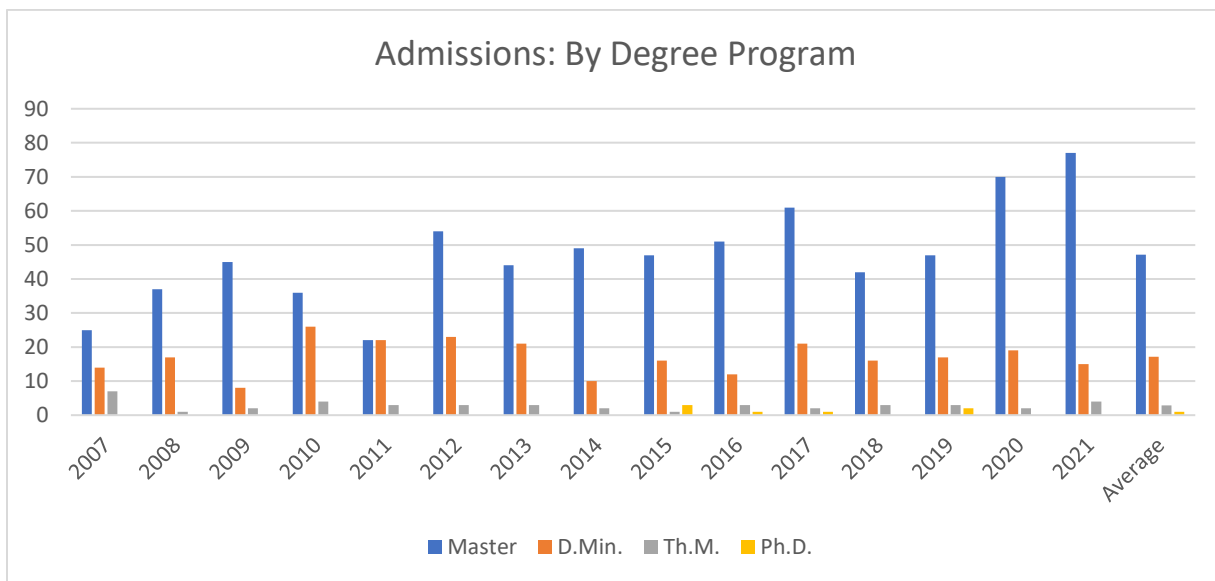

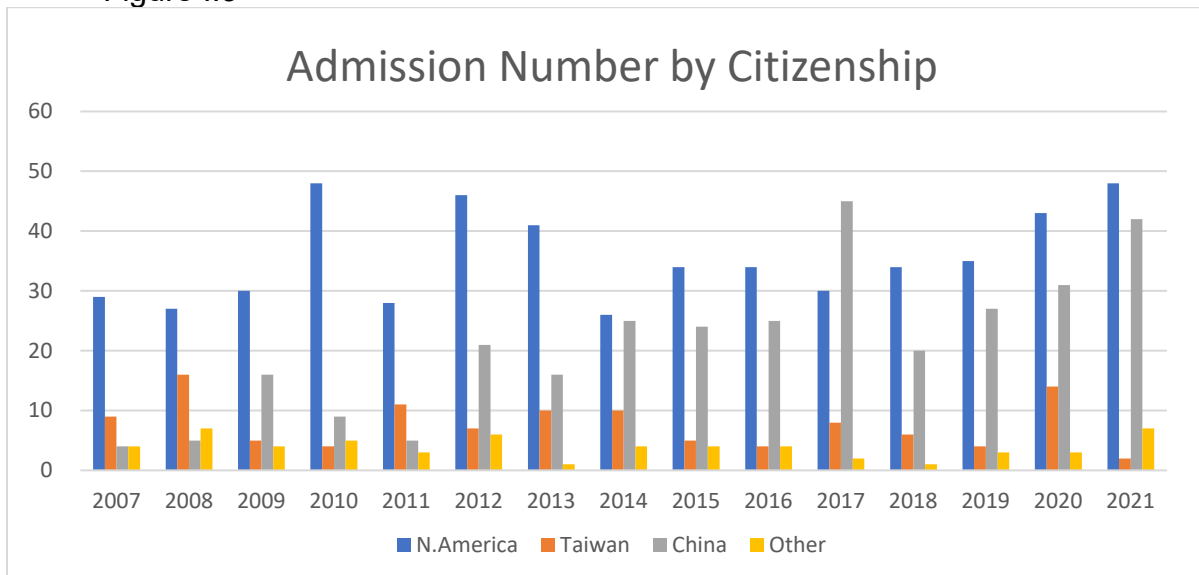

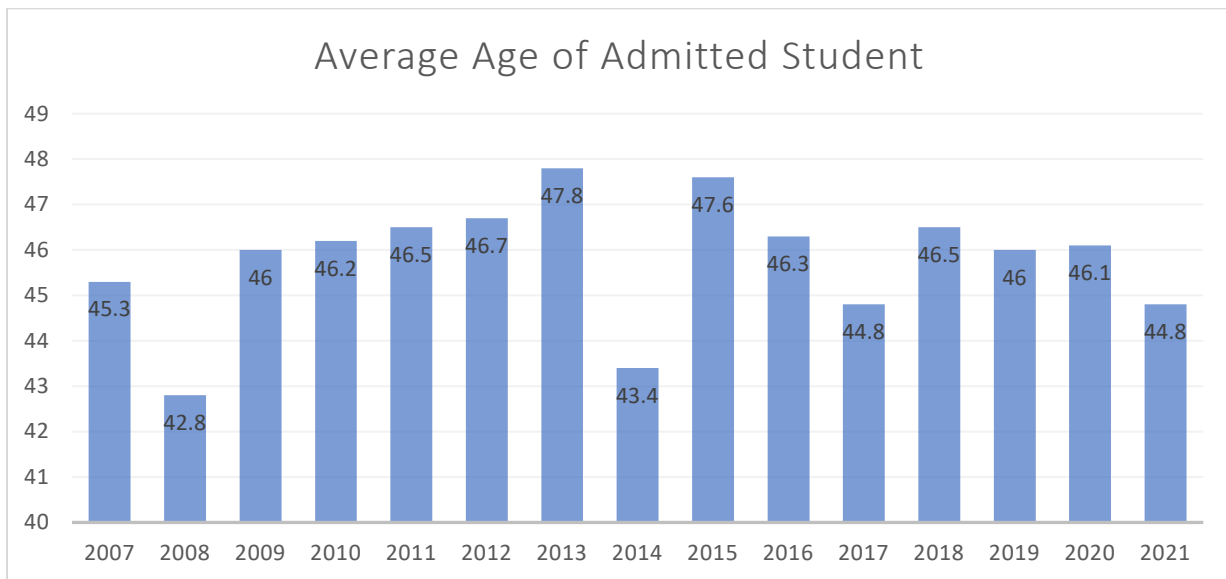

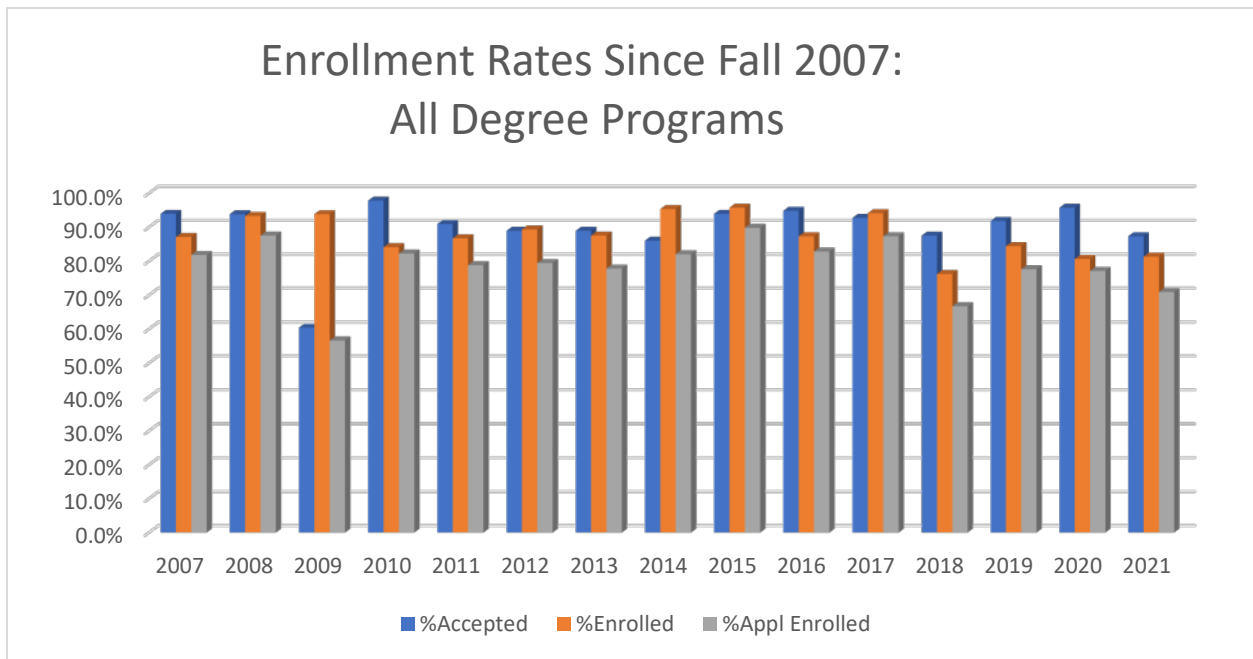

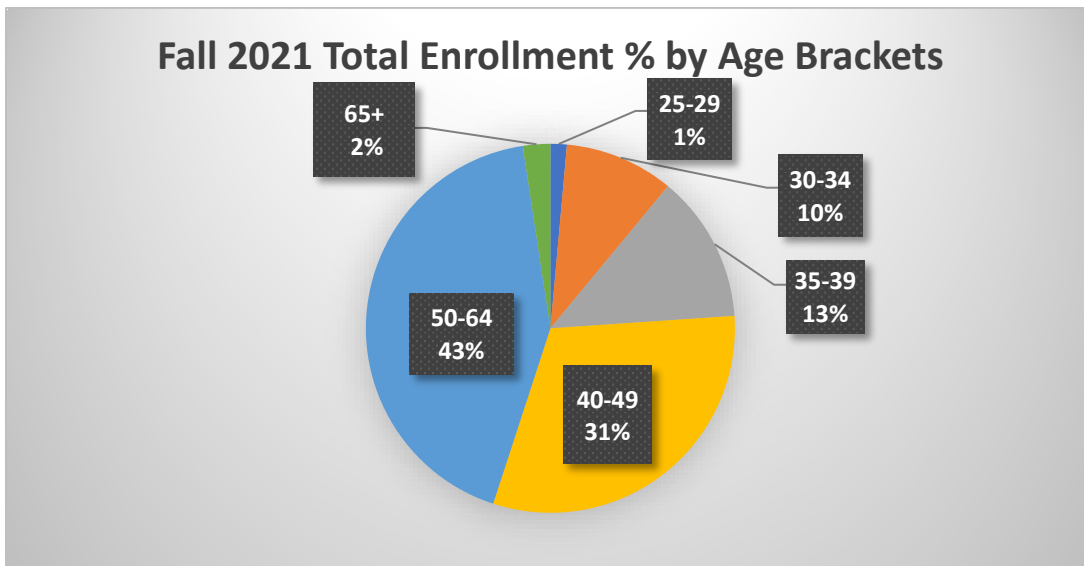

### II.1 Highlights

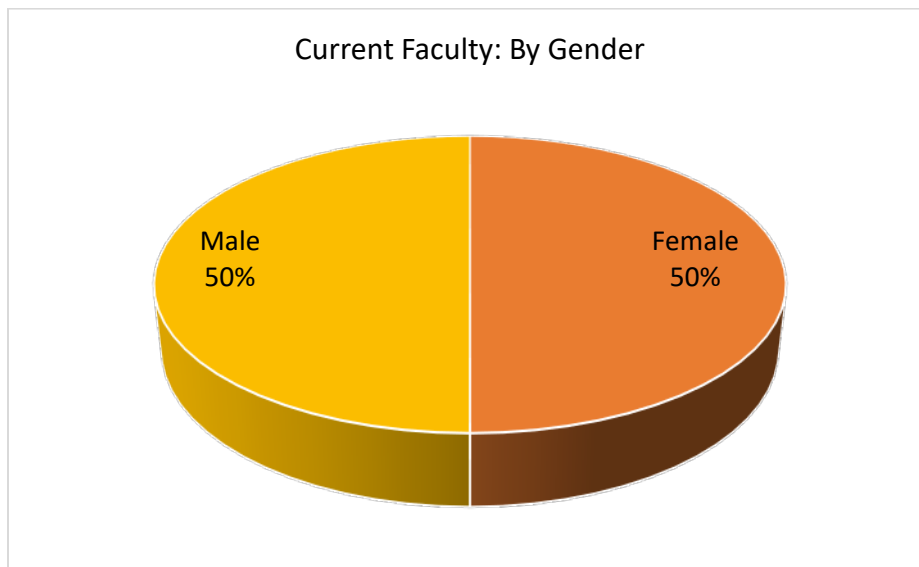
- **Age, Gender, Denomination, and Educational Background:** The present faculty team is well-balanced in diversity of age bracket, denomination, gender, and educational background.

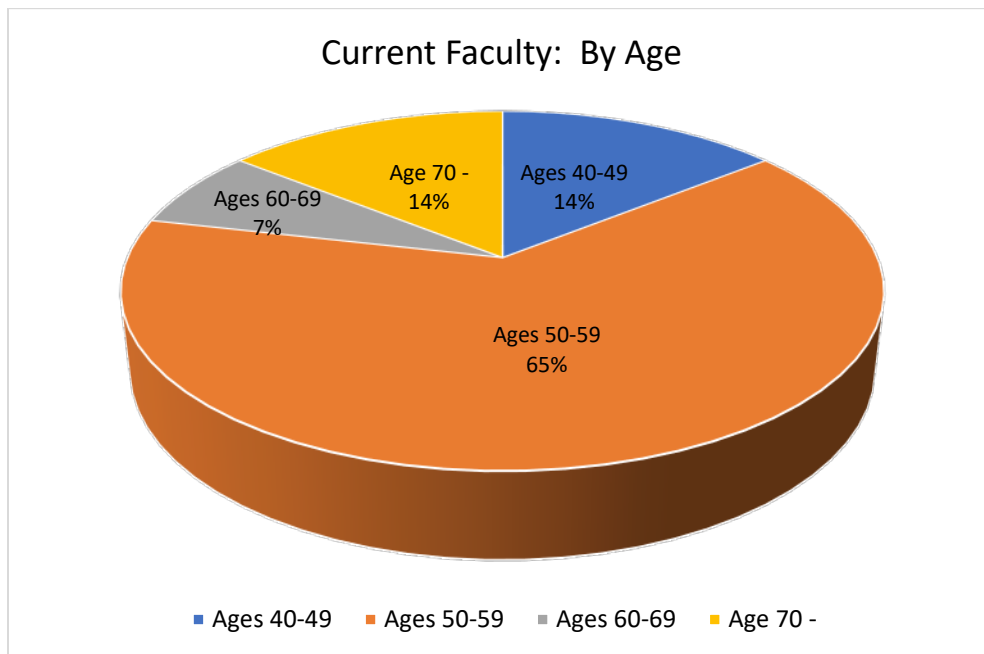

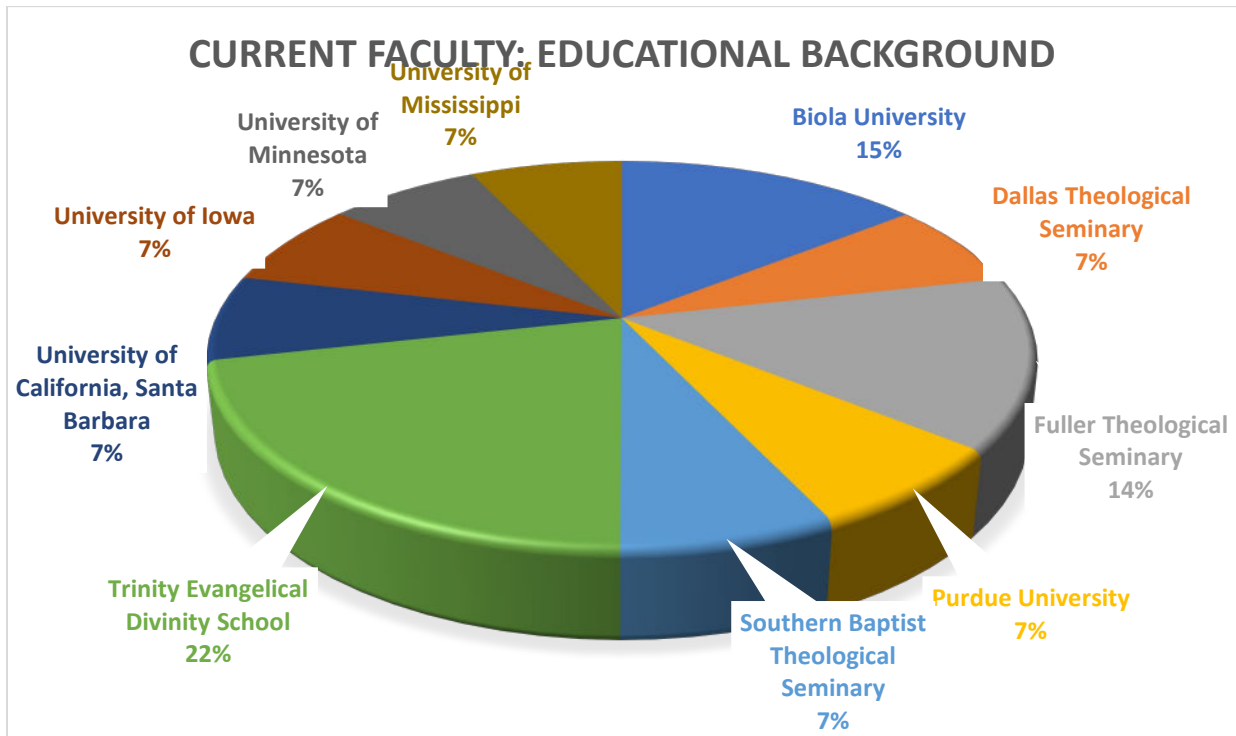

## III. Alum Profile

### III.1 Highlights

- **Degrees Conferred:** 55 degrees have been conferred in the year 2021. Of all the degrees conferred, M.Div. graduates are top of all other programs.
- **Ministry Placement:** 12% of the Logos' graduates from the past four years are engaged in non-congregational ministry. The percentage for congregational ministry has increased to 62%, which is 13-15% higher than total in previous decades.
- **Ministry Placement for M.Div. Graduates:** Of the entire Logos' M.Div. graduates from the past four years, 71% are engaged in congregational ministry. 7% are active students. The percentage for still seeking and between ministry is 9%.

### IV.1 Highlights

- **Foundation Value:** In 2021, the foundation assets had 21.29% increased from 2020. The change ratio depends on contribution and investment return. The foundation is professionally managed by LESF Board and experienced investors.

- **Operating Revenue and Expenditure:** Our Tuition Collections were \$0.96M and our Instruction Expenses were \$1.92M in 2021. The amount of the tuition collected had dropped to 20.5% of our \$4.7M annual expenses. The percentage of expenses for scholarship and student services has doubled since 2019.



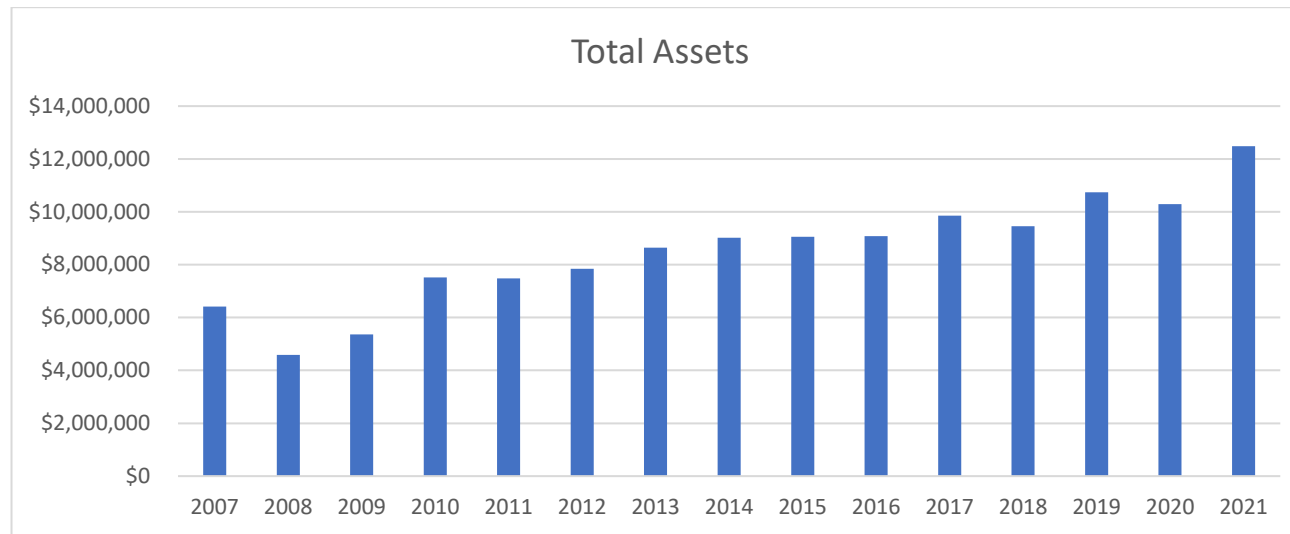
