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Introduction

2023-2024 Logos Seminary Fact Book

Institutional Research (IR), as an intentional and directed service, was introduced at Logos Seminary in February 2009. The goal of IR is to identify, collect, and distribute key or necessary institutional data, to track institutional effectiveness, particularly with respect to strategic planning and departmental goals and key measurements. The 2009 Seminary Fact Book became the first concentrated and tangible reporting of IR by Logos Seminary. This publication is now in its 15th year. Much of the data has been used for analysis and assessment by departments. It is also available for public access through Logos website, www.les.edu.

I. Current Student Body Profile

I.1 Highlights

- Admissions: The total number of admitted students for 2024 (academic year) is 88. 74% is for master's degree programs, and 25% is for Doctor of Ministry program. The average age of all admitted students is 45.9. Students are coming from regions of China, Taiwan, Germany, Australia, Thailand, and Uganda. 41 admitted students were from China which comprised 46.6% of total admitted students.
- *Enrollment:* The total enrollment for all programs is 202, which is almost the same as the level of the past four years. Enrollment in the M.A.C.S. program has increased by 23.5% from 2023.
- **Gender:** The overall enrollment percentage for males has increased and has surpassed 50% this year, differing from the past four years. Male enrollment in the M.A.C.S. program has risen by 39% from 2023. The M.A.F.M. program continues to be the most popular program among females.
- Age: The average age of all students is 45.9, which is the lowest since 2008 (the earliest year in this statistics). 53.87% of all program students are under 50. The age group between 50-64 has the largest percentage of Master of Divinity students at 31.71%, this is lower than 2023's 53.6%. This trend should be considered and reflected in the program and curriculum design.
- **Graduation and Retention Rate:** The graduation rate for all programs appears to be continuously decreasing. Additionally, the retention rate for most programs has declined from the previous year. The primary factor behind these two phenomena is the continuous increase in part-time and online students.








Table I.5.B Enrollment Rates: Annually (Fall) for M.Div Program




Figure I.5.B Enrollment Rates: Annually (Fall) for M.Div Program










I.9 FTE (Full Time Equivalent) Enrollment



II.1 Highlights


- Age, Gender, Denomination, and Educational Background: The present faculty team is well-balanced in diversity of age bracket, denomination, gender, and educational background.





III. Alum Profile

III.1 Highlights

- Degrees Conferred: 14 degrees have been conferred in the year 2024. The total of all degrees conferred by Logos has accumulated to 880. Of all the degrees conferred, M.Div. graduates are top of all other programs, 357 which is 41% of all degrees.
- *Ministry Placement:* 13% of Logos' graduates from the past seven years are engaged in non-congregational ministry. The percentage for congregational ministry has increased to 57%, while the percentage for cross-cultural ministry is 2%.
- *Ministry Placement for M.Div. Graduates:* Of the entire Logos' M.Div. graduates from the past seven years, 68% are engaged in congregational ministry. 9% are pursuing further studies. The percentage for still seeking and between ministry is 6%.










